Criteria for The Aldo Leopold Award

The Aldo Leopold Award is given by the Floyds Fork Environmental Association to honor a person or organization that, as determined by the FFEA Board of Directors, by word and deed, has helped bring Leopold's vision of a "Land Ethic" closer to a reality.

- *"The land ethic simply enlarges the boundaries of the community to include soils, waters, plants, and animals, or collectively: the land... In short, a land ethic changes the role of Homo sapiens from conqueror of the land-community to plain member and citizen of it. It implies respect for his fellow-members, and also respect for the community as such."*

"We abuse land because we regard it as a commodity belonging to us. When we see land as a community to which we belong, we may begin to use it with love and respect."

- \$300 "Support" Award and a one year single FFEA membership
- Nomination is required and nominee must agree to accept. A photo and short bio are requested.
- Nominee can be an individual (18 and over), a business or organization. The business or organization must exemplify the characteristics noted above.
- Nominee can be a self-nomination and must exemplify the characteristics noted above.
- While the award may be awarded posthumously, if the recipient is living, the award may not be conferred in absentia.
